

Articles of Incorporation

I
The name of the corporation is: Pete Brown Scholarship Fund (PBSF)

II
A. This corporation is a nonprofit **Public Benefit Corporation** and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized for the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for

- public purposes
- charitable purposes
- public and charitable purposes

B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to: *"Keep the tennis legacy alive in our community". We accomplish this by focusing on developing the complete junior tennis player. Therefore promoting tennis games and enhancing skill sets of at risk and inner city junior tennis players (both on and off the tennis court) in the community.*
